



Social Security Card Application Materials For F-1 Visa Status

On-campus employment may be available to F-1 students who are in a degree program, are maintaining full time study, have achieved good grades, and have met their financial obligations to the University. F-1 students must receive a U.S. Social Security card and completed the necessary employment documents before they can obtain permission to work on campus. Information on obtaining a U.S. Social Security Card is given to new students during orientation.

The following documents are needed in order to apply for a social security card:

1. I-20
2. I-94
3. Passport
4. Letter from the Primary Designated School Official (PDSO), Dr. Todd Reynolds, requesting issuance of social security card.
5. Letter signed by from campus employer
