Tips for General Education Requirements:

To graduate is 4 years students must take an average of 15 hours per semester to earn the minimum required 120 hours; many majors require more hours per semester or summer classes. Of the 120 hours, you must take at least 40 upper level (300-400) hours. You must take at least 12 hours to be full time.

You are required to declare a major by your Junior year.

Speech: If you are considering Education then take SPC-220 or wait to take this requirement. SPC-220 is the only acceptable speech class for Education majors.

Mathematics: If you are considering any of the Business/Sociology/Psychology majors wait to take MTH-310. It will benefit you more if you do not take it your first year. It is ok to not take mathematics your first year. If you are completely undecided, it is better if you wait, so you take the correct mathematics course.

Philosophy/religion – Ethics courses will not fulfill this requirement, even though they have the prefix of REL or PHI.

Cross Cultural – If you are a considering majoring in ANY of the business areas you will be encouraged to take MGT-340 to fulfill this requirement, so you should wait. If you are considering Sociology, you should go ahead and take ANT-149. It will count for general education and the major.

Ethics – If you are considering ANY of the Business majors you should wait to take this requirement. Later you will be encouraged to take MGT/MKT-424 to fulfill this requirement. If you are considering majoring in Environmental Studies , you should wait to take this requirement or take PHI-208 as it is a requirement for the major and will fulfill the general education requirement.

History – if you are considering Education, you must take a United States History course or wait.

Computer Science – If you are considering being an education major, do not take your computer science requirement. You will be required to take EDU-115, but should wait until you take EDU-210 to do this.
