McKendree University Post-Master's Certificate

Nurses who have successfully obtained a MSN may enroll in McKendree University's Post-Master's certificate program. Post-Master's certificates are available in nursing education or nursing management/administration. Coursework for the Post-Master's Certificate will begin annually in summer. Coursework can be completed in three semesters for the educator option, and two semesters for the manager/administrator option. All coursework is available in an online format. Upon completion of the 14 credit hours, Post-Master's students will receive a certificate.

Tuition costs for 2015-2016 are \$430.00 per credit hour and \$60.00 per credit hour online fees. Textbook costs range from \$50.00 - \$200 per course.
