Instructional Delivery – Face to Face

McKendree University Residency – Students must complete a minimum of 30 credit hours with McKendree University.

Transfer Credits – McKendree University will accept a maximum of 90 hours in transfer credits. Only courses with a grade of C or better will be transferred.

Degree Requirements – Students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours to receive a bachelor's degree from McKendree University. Some programs require additional hours. Elective hours required at McKendree University may vary depending on total hours accepted in transfer.
