Articulation Agreement Between

McKendree University and Kaskaskia College AAS - ACC to Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting

This articulation agreement is the result of discussions between McKendree University and Kaskaskia College. McKendree and Kaskaskia agree that both institutions value this cooperative agreement and that this agreement will best serve the current students of both institutions.

Terms and Conditions

Section I: Admissions and Matriculation

McKendree and Kaskaskia have developed a four-year program plan to facilitate the most seamless transfer possible for Kaskaskia students who complete the Associate in Applied Science (AAS) Degree in Accounting at Kaskaskia and desire to earn the Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting at McKendree University.

Students who satisfactorily complete the AAS requirements with Kaskaskia College will be admitted to McKendree University.

McKendree and Kaskaskia agree to inform potential transfer students of the existence of these institutional articulation agreements and the advantages of pursuing the articulated programs.

Section II: Transfer of credit

McKendree University agrees to accept a maximum of 90 semester hours of credit from the Kaskaskia graduate who seeks to complete a baccalaureate degree at McKendree. McKendree University will communicate specific options for students and give careful consideration to all previously completed courses. Courses in addition to those used to earn the AAS degree at Kaskaskia will be evaluated individually to determine which are transferable and what requirements have been met. Completion of the AAS fulfills all general education requirements with McKendree University.

Section III: Program Plan

The four-year plan for the Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting is included at the end of this agreement. This plan will specify the student degree course plan and transfer credit requirements.

Degree course plans will be reviewed by both McKendree University and Kaskaskia representatives on an annual basis, and revised or updated as needed to reflect any changes in the degree requirements.

Terms of the Agreement

This agreement becomes effective on August 1, 2021 and remains in effect until July 31, 2025, unless changed in writing by mutual agreement of McKendree University and Kaskaskia College. The agreement can be amended at any time with the approval of both institutions. Should either institution desire to discontinue this agreement, written advance notification of 60 days will be required. Termination, however, will not be executed without a negotiated teach-out agreement for students currently enrolled.

Both institutions hereby indicate full agreement to the terms and conditions included above and the honoring of the course, program, and other requirements outlined in the four and one half year program plans attached at the end of this agreement.
