



## McKendree University WYSE Scholarships

McKendree University partners with World Wide Youth in Science and Engineering (WYSE) to hold two academic challenge events on campus. Students come to campus each year to participate in both a regional and sectional event.

Students that meet the following criteria will be awarded a McKendree University WYSE scholarship:

1. Scholarships are awarded to senior students that have applied and been accepted to McKendree University for the Fall 2013 school term.
2. Students must qualify for and attend one of McKendree's academic scholarship events:

Presidential Leadership Event	Honor's Leadership Event
3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale AND	3.6 GPA on a 4.0 scale AND
22 or higher composite ACT	27 or higher composite ACT
<b>January 26 and 27, 2013</b>	<b>January 27, 2013</b>
3. Students must participate in either the Missouri WYSE regional or Illinois WYSE sectional at McKendree and place 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in any individual event. Students that do not place individually are not eligible even if their teams place.

Scholarship details:

1. The WYSE scholarship is a renewable award valued at \$1,000 per academic year. Students can earn up to \$2,000 per academic year if they place (1, 2, or 3) in two individual events.
2. The scholarship may only be used towards the cost of tuition at McKendree and can be paired with a student's academic scholarship.

Coach Referrals

In the case that no student from a participating team accepts the McKendree WYSE scholarship, the team coach can nominate one deserving senior student. The student must be accepted to McKendree and have attended one of the academic scholarship events. Students that have been nominated will be awarded \$1,000 per academic year.
