TOURNAMENT RULES & REGULATIONS

Eligibility: The tournament is sanctioned by USBC Collegiate and will comply with all USBC rules and regulations and conduct. All member teams of the USBC Collegiate Bowling Program are eligible to participate. All team members must be eligible according to USBC Collegiate eligibility rules.

Entries: Multiple entries will be accepted. All participating teams entered in the tournament are eligible for awards based on final results.

Entry Fees: **\$250.00 per team.** Make Check Payable to McKendree University

Divisions: There will be two (2) divisions. There will be a men's division and a women's division. Any team consisting of mixed gender must compete in the men's division.

Squads: There will be one (1) squad. We do have the ability to run two (2) squads if entries warrant it.

Team Rosters: A roster may consist of up to eight (8) bowlers. A legal line up must consist of a minimum of five (5) bowlers. If a team has less than 5 bowlers, they will receive a score of zero (0) for that roster spot each game.

Substitutions: A team may only make three (3) substitutions per game. Once removed a player may not return during that game.

Attire: Teams are required to have matching uniforms that conform to USBC Collegiate rules. This includes matching collared shirts with approved USBC Collegiate logos. Men must wear matching slacks. Women must wear matching shorts, skorts, skirts, or slacks. Jeans or cargo pants are not permitted.

Alcohol/Tobacco: All Bowlers, Coaches, and Staff will refrain from smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages during competition.

Lane Conditions: Lane conditions will be Sport Bowling compliant as determined by USBC. The lanes will be re-oiled between squads.

Tournament Format: The tournament will consist of 24 baker games on Saturday and 16 baker games on Sunday. All scores are scratch with NO BONUS pins. After 40 Baker Games field will be cut to top 8 teams in each division for a 2 out of 3 Baker format elimination bracket to determine tournament champion.
