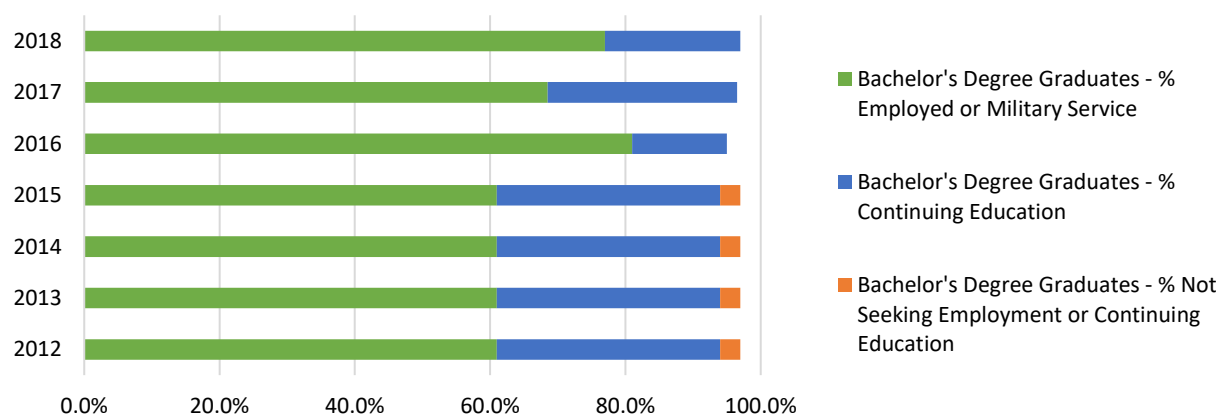
The Higher Learning Commission reaffirmed the accreditation of McKendree University for a ten-year period. The next accreditation review will be held in 2028-2029.

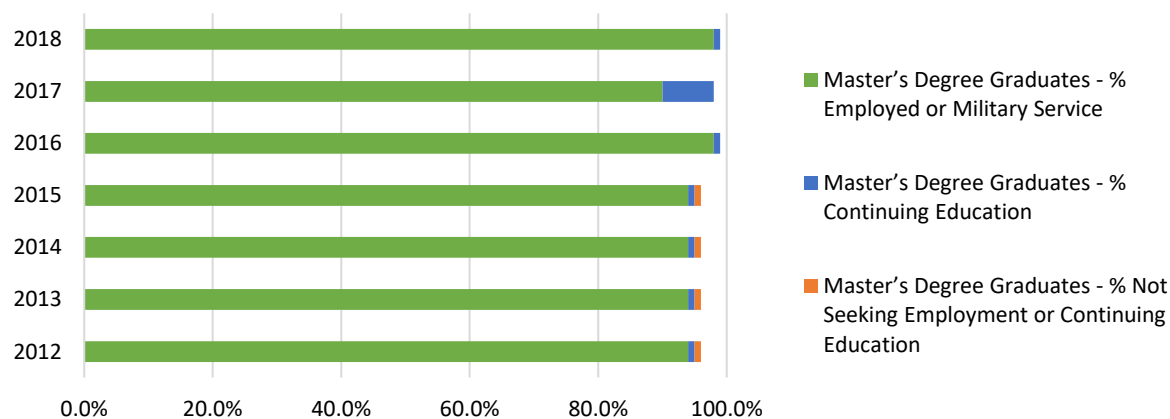

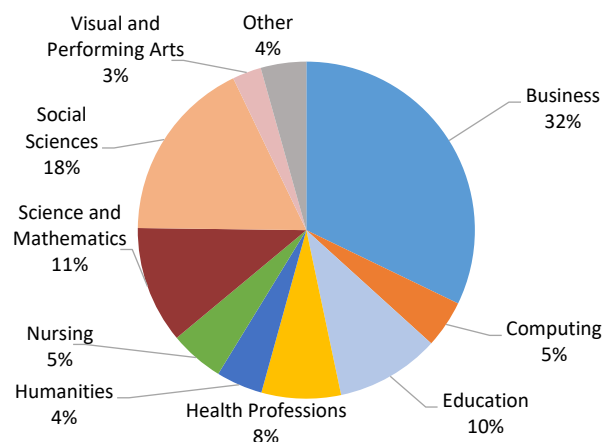

Student Headcount, New Lebanon UN, FTFY, by Division

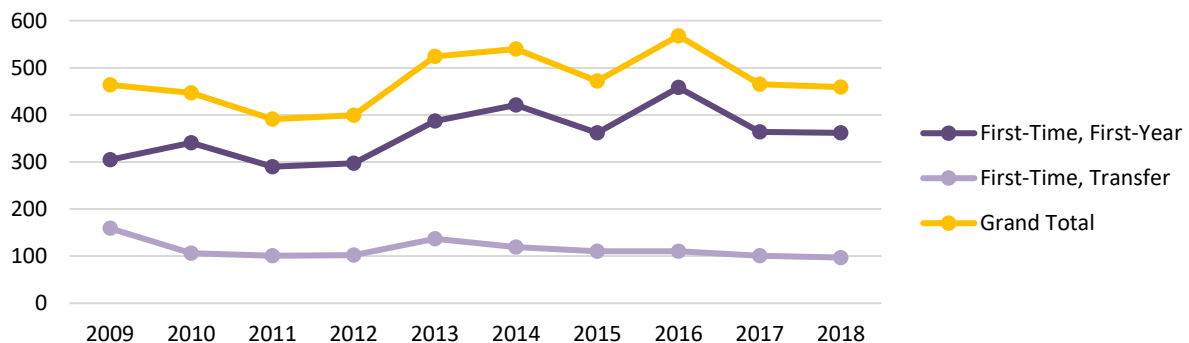


Student Headcount, New Lebanon UN, FTT, by Division

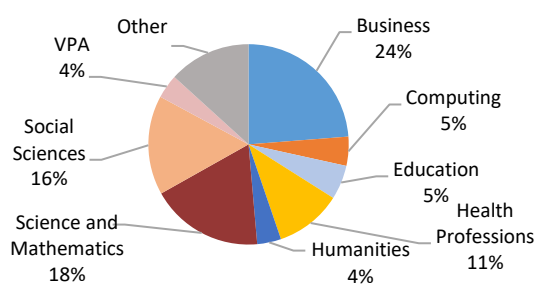

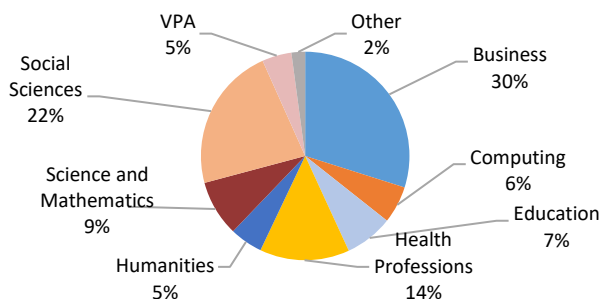

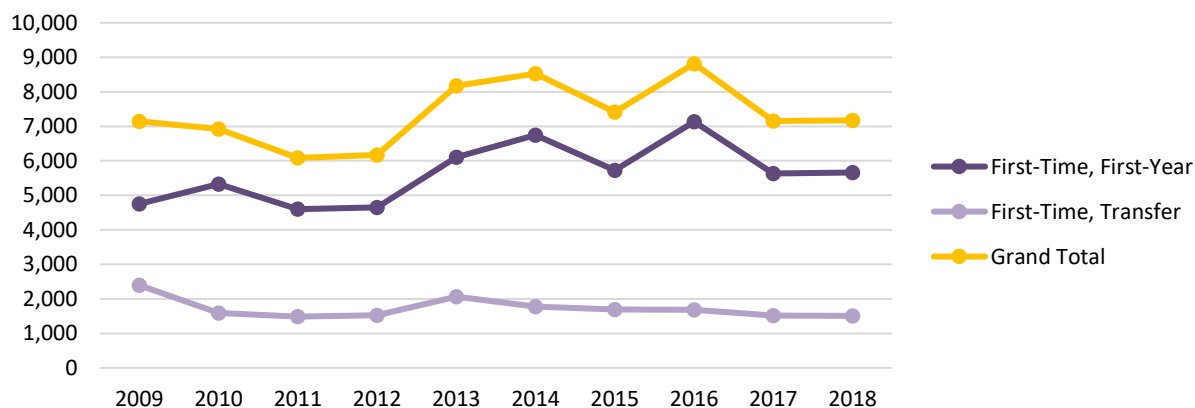


Credit Hours, New Lebanon UN, FTT, by Division

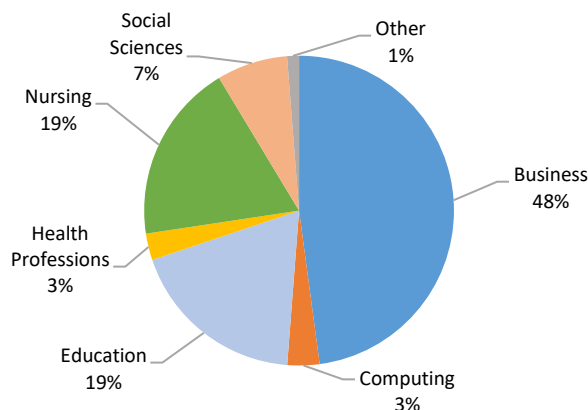
