There is no entry fee for participating businesses. Funds received will be donated to the American Red Cross. It is recommended that teams prepare a minimum of 250 wings per competition category. Restaurants are allowed to prepare wings at their respective institutions or they may prepare them on site with approval. Teams must bring utensils, warming equipment (i.e. sterno type warmers), paper towels, items for wing storage, and trash bags. Canopies and umbrellas (if wanted) will be the team's responsibility. (1) 10x10 tent, (1) 8-Foot table and 4 chairs will be provided.

Guidelines for participating at the McKendree University Spring Fling Wing Thing are listed and are **SUBJECT TO CHANGE**

Benefits of Participation

As a participant in the 2013 Spring Fling Wing thing, your restaurant will compete to for a variety of honors, including "Bearcat Best Wing," which will be awarded to the restaurant with the best overall wings. Any of our prestigious honors will give you bragging rights for the next year, and an impressive trophy for your building to announce your award. Even if your restaurant doesn't win, the event will provide exposure to our students and members of the community. It's a fun and affordable way to get your name out there and let everyone know that YOU have the best wings around. Plus you will be supporting a great cause too!

- Bragging rights for having the best wings in the area

Judging (People's Choice Award):

1. Attendees will receive a ballot to vote for People's Choice at the ticket table. They will complete the ballot with the name of their favorite team and turn it back in at the ticket table.

Judging (Bearcat Best, Hot Chick on Campus, and Most Creative):

Using a scale of 1-5 for a total of 15 points, wings will be judged in the following manner:

- 2. Appearance/Presentation Do the wings look appetizing?
- 3. Texture and Tenderness Are the wings crispy, while still juicy on the inside? Are they rubbery?
- 4. Sauce/Seasoning and Flavor
- 5. Originality (Creative Wing) Is the sauce made from scratch? Are the ingredients unique and unexpected? (An ingredient list would greatly help)

Application & Fees

1. **There is no fee to participate in the McKendree University Spring Fling Wing Thing**. Funds collected from the event will be donated to The American Red Cross. Participating businesses are asked to bring a minimum of 250 chicken wings per selected competition category and serving supplies.

Teams and Booth Set Up:

- 1. Each team shall consist of up to 4 people. Upon arrival at the site, the team captain must check in with the registration table for area assignment, and any new information concerning the cook-off.
- 2. Team's booth area must be set up and ready to serve by 1:45 p.m. Elaborate area designs are encouraged but not mandatory. Public displays and demonstrations are encouraged as a part of crowd involvement.
- 3. We will provide a 10x10 tent, (1) 8-foot table, 4 chairs. Pits, cookers, props, trailers, decorations, etc., should not exceed the team's assigned area. Any team that wishes to cook or finish their wings on site must have appropriate equipment for disposal of any charcoals. Additionally, a fire extinguisher shall be near all cooking devices/ Teams must bring wings, utensils, cooking/warming equipment (i.e. sterno type warmers), serving equipment, paper towels, and trash bags. Hand sanitizer or sanitary wipe type items are required at each table.

Ingredients & Preparation:

Restaurants are encouraged to prepare wings at their respective establishments and make deliveries to campus. No Boneless wings allowed. Wings can be prepared on site at the event using your own equipment (grill/fryer), pending approval from the University. Teams must provide their own wings. It is recommended that teams prepare a minimum of 250 wings per selected competition category. In the event you run low on wings, you may have deliveries made from your restaurant.

Selling and Promotion:

Tickets will be sold to spectators at the cost of 10 tickets for \$6.00. They will trade the tickets in for wings at a participant's table. Individual, single tickets will cost \$.75. Proceeds from ticket sales will be donated to The American Red Cross. Vendors are allowed to have coupons and other restaurant literature available at their booth. This is a great time to promote your business!

Booth teardown: Approximately 5:30 p.m.

Areas must be cleaned up at the end of the event. Trash must be placed in provided dumpster. This includes any food waste or significant spills; customer discarded serving containers and implements, all cooking waste, and any raw food containers.
