

Intramural Official/Scorekeeper

The Campus Activities Office employs a number of students through the Federal Work Study system. Staff members will be selected based on completion of the below requirements, and a brief interview if necessary.

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Must be a full time, currently enrolled McKendree student registered for the upcoming semester with Federal Work Study.
- 2. Must be in good standing with McKendree both academically and judicially.
- 3. Must be able to work weekend or evening shifts.
- 4. Shall have a minimum of 5 hours of Federal Work Study allotted per week.
- 5. General sports rules knowledge required.
- 6. American Red Cross First Aid/CPR/AED certification highly preferred.
- 7. Completed online application for Campus Activities Work Study
- 8. Completed Financial Aid Checklist and required signatures.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Attend all mandatory meetings and training sessions as specified; demonstrate understanding of rules and officiating
- 2. Responsible for the complete game control of all officiated Intramural contests.
- 3. Arrive early and prepared for all scheduled shifts.
- 4. Maintain honesty and integrity during all Intramural events.
- 5. Maintain a professional demeanor at all times
- 6. General facility cleaning and maintenance; inspect/prepare playing areas for safety prior to play
- 7. Manage players/spectators on the field/court; Maintain a courteous and helpful attitude
- 8. Not only officiate, but assist players with learning more about the activity in which they are participating.
- 9. Enforce and evaluate the sportsmanship of Intramural teams and participants
- 10. Check in participants and teams prior to play. Make sure correct attire is worn (ie. no jewelry, illegal equipment, etc.)
- 11. Participate in other aspects of the game (scorekeeper, etc.)
- 12. Assist with captain's and/or team meetings prior to competition.
- 13. Report and post results and scores of competition
- 14. Address on-site issues and disputes; communicate with Head Official or Coordinator (ie. incidents, player conduct, conflict and rule clarifications, participant and spectator conduct, equipment damage, etc.) verbally and in writing
- 15. Serve as a Recreation General Staff member substitute.
- 16. Other duties as specified.
