1 2	CONCERNED that in the United States the overdose death rate has increased by 21.5%, and
3	ALARMED BY a 52.4% rise in death rate from overdosing on cocaine, and
4	
5	NOTING that Peru is the largest producer of coca plants, and
6	
7	NOTING FURTHER that Peru farmers planted 60,400 hectares of coca, according to the United
8	Nations Office on Drug and Crime (UNODC), and
9	
10	ENCOURGED by the United States actions of decreasing drug trafficking in Peru and
11	surrounding countries, by providing 85 million dollars in 2018 to combat the production of
12	narcotics, as well as the trafficking of such drugs, and the destruction of their crops, but
13 14	DEEPLY REGRETING that the tactics used for destroying narcotic-producing plants killed all
14 15	other plant life in the designated and targeted areas, but
16	other plant me in the designated and targeted areas, out
17	FULLY AWARE that where the plants are farmed are the most productive rural areas of Peru,
18	and
19	
20	DEEPLY DISTURBED that even though the actions of the U.N., the United States, and other
21	countries have taken, Peru has become again the number one producer of cocaine, even above
22	Colombia;

24	<u>REALIZING</u> that the actions of those bodies are not strong enough to stop this crisis;
25	
26	1) <u>EMPHASIZING</u> the end of trafficking and production of drugs in Peru, which by
27	2025 we want to cut the production in half by destroying the fields of the less fertile
28	areas;

30	2) <u>REQUESTS</u> \$250 million over the next 10 years, by the U.N., for responsibly
31	destroying those narcotic-producing plants;

33	3) <u>REMINDS that this funding is very much needed and could help all countries in the</u>
34	America's by reducing trafficking, overdoses, and murders.
