1 RECOGNIZING that trade wars have serious, negative effects on various world economic structures, and

3 CONTEMPLATING that the trade wars drastically increase the prices of essentials goods, as seen with

4 current conflicts, and

5

6 DEEPLY CONCERNED that the negative effects of trade wars are hurting most the citizens of the world,

7 who suffer through loss of money, loss of products, or loss of sales, and

8

9 EMPHASIZING that international trade wars can easily escalate into a physical war conflict, and

10

11 DEEPLY CONVINCED that the United Nations should intervene in these problematic ordeals, to

12 stabilize not only the industries and economies of individual countries, but also the international

13 marketplace where third party countries could also be affected;

15 1) TAKE NOTE of the crisis experienced by nations affected by trade war, such as unobtainable

16 food or life essentials;

18 2) ENCOURAGES countries engaged in tariff disputes to seek new trade partners with other

19 countries that trade equivalent or compatible goods;

21 3) STRONGLY RECOMMEND that all countries of the UN agree to establish a Global Trade

22 Enforcement Syndicate (or the GTES) to fulfill the following functions;

24 (a) Monitor and regulate trade negotiations between countries;

26 (b) Facilitate the establishment of fair and consistent tariffs;

28 (c) Promote trade between all countries involved, by providing a fair and efficient system.
