

As soon as I walked into the morning session for the General Assembly committee, I noticed right away that they were hard at work. The delegates are still debating topic 3 resolution 2, and they are working hard on making this resolution passable, and have even passed an amendment since I last left the committee to write up my first report. A short while after I took my seat, they had passed an amendment which was added to the resolution, which is concerning the procedures to intervene in countries with cases of civil unrest. They had another amendment that was debated on, which involved the formation of a subcommittee. A subcommittee is a group of delegates who talk about the issue at hand. The delegate from France stated that the formation of a subcommittee will not help the situation and will not contain as much force as if a peaceful intervention was to be used. The delegate also stated that if countries already had plans and ideas on how to handle the cases of civil unrest, and a subcommittee were to be formed and used to tell countries what they should do when they already have plans, the formation of a subcommittee would likely cause tension and create an unnecessary bureaucracy.

The amendment in question is being whittled down to being just ended in debate and be passed. The delegate of Russia suggested that the debate on the amendment should be closed and passed so they can move on to work on even more needed amendments to finish making the resolution passable.

The debate on the amendment was closed. The amendment, which states that all UN actions are decided by a subcommittee, has been added to resolution 3-2.

Another amendment has been suggested, which says that a committee be formed for dealing with situations of countries in civil unrest. This amendment being debated only has 3 pro con speakers, which are the delegates of Kuwait, China, and Russia, and only one con speaker- the delegate from Lebanon.

The first pro speaker, the delegate from Kuwait, asked for the other pro speakers to strike themselves from the pro speakers' list seeing as how only there was only one speaker speaking con that it would be pointless to continue debated with not many speakers. The delegate also stated that he believes that the statement that peaceful intervention never works, he states, is, quote "an odious".

There was a recent motion that was passed to change the speaking time to less than the original so as to resolve this issue of civil unrest more quickly.

The delegate of China says that he is in favor of this amendment as the committee is almost done with making the resolution passable as it takes all 3 of their amendments that were discussed during the Committee of the Whole and puts them into action.

The delegate from Panama states that we are much closer to a possible World War III, and that the danger grows every day, and that the UN could have enemies planning to take them down, and this is all due to all the evil in this world. Panama's delegate also keeps referring to a group of people he caused "they". When asked who "they" were, the delegate simply replied, quote, "I don't know".

Russia's delegate suggested that the committee combine the 3 amendments already made and combine them into one single operative clause to resolution 3-2.
